We're improving pedestrian and cyclist safety, and doing road maintenance on Merton Road, Glen Innes

Kia ora,

We are making great progress on stage 1 of the Merton East cycleway upgrades, between the Apirana and Morrin roundabouts.

Up next, we plan to start constructing the pedestrian and cyclist upgrades at the Merton Road, Morrin Road and Felton Matthew Road roundabout from Monday 27 October for 8 weeks over 3 stages.

Work will take place between 7:00 pm to 6:00 am throughout the week. No work will take place on between 6am Saturday and 7:00 pm Sunday the following day.

Please note that inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances may delay the start or completion of the works. If there are significant delays, we will keep you informed.

These works are part of the Links to Glen Innes Cycleways project, which aims to create more options for people to travel safely and sustainably in our growing communities.

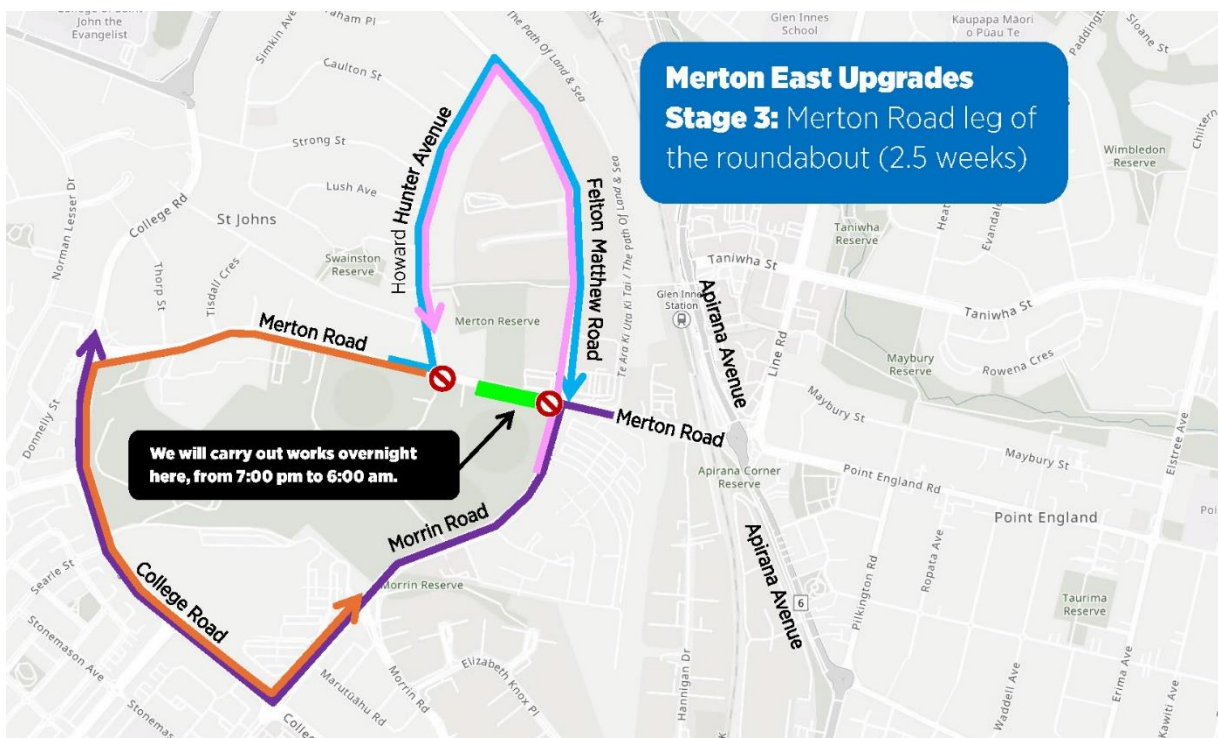
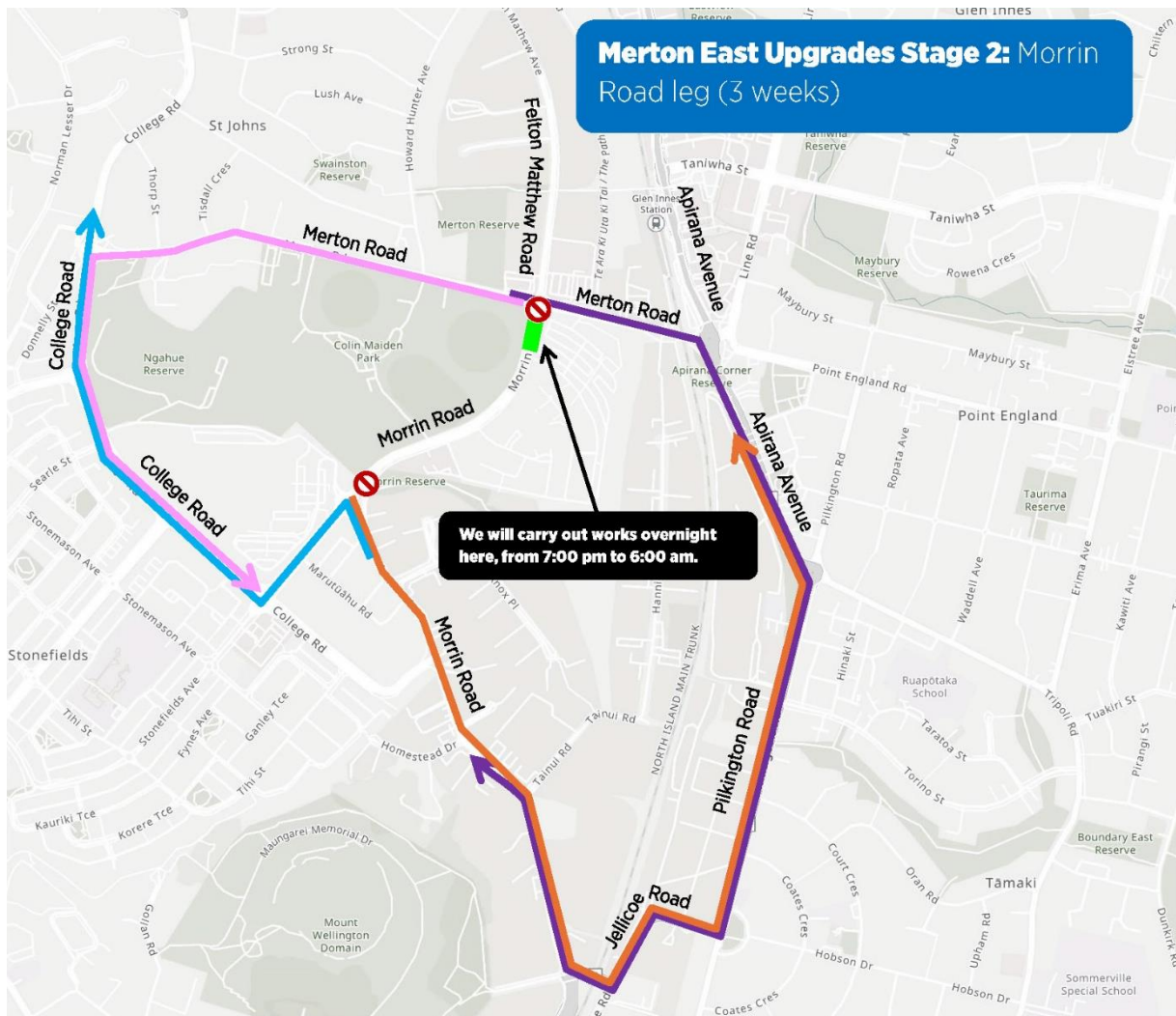

Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	Merton Road, Morrin Road, and Felton Matthew Avenue roundabout
When	Work at the roundabout will be completed over 8 weeks. We will be working in stages to minimise the level of disruption: • Stage 2: Morrin Road (3 weeks) • Stage 3: Merton Road (2.5 weeks) • Stage 4: Felton Mathew Avenue (2 weeks) Please see the maps below showing where we will be working.
What we're doing	Constructing new pedestrian and cyclist crossings at the Morrin, Merton, and Felton Matthew Road roundabout. We will also deliver road maintenance and renewal works, including footpath, kerb and channel upgrades, and some asphalt resurfacing.
How it may impact you	On-street parking will be limited during the works.
How travel is affected	Full road closures will be in place during hours of work to redirect traffic around the work site. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions. Outside of work hours, normal traffic flow will be restored. Traffic controllers will be on site to help drivers and pedestrians around the work site. Access to businesses and shops would be maintained.
