


# Watermain Renewals

Kia ora,

From October 13, Watercare and our contractors will begin work to upgrade a section of watermain along Mansfield Street, Glen Innes (see map below). These works are a part of Watercare's Renewals Programme which replaces aging watermains, reducing the risks of leaks and disruption to the water supply of Glen Innes.



## **How will these works affect you?**

- These works are expected to take approximately **3-4 weeks** to complete.
- Work hours will typically be from **7.00am – 5.00pm Monday to Saturday**. Saturday work will be a comparatively shorter window of working time. There may be up to **2-3 nights of work** required. If needed, night works will run from **7:00pm to 5:00am**.
- While the work may generate some noise, please be assured that it will be kept to a minimum and within levels approved by Auckland Council.
- Toward the end of the project, we will need to undertake a water shutdown. We will notify affected parties five days in advance of the shutdown, and it will be planned at a time that will minimise disruption.
- The water meter serving your property may be replaced during these renewal works. If we need to access your property you will be notified in advance.
- You may also notice the following temporary changes along Mansfield Street and surrounding streets in Glen Innes.
  - Reduced on street parking
  - Reduced lane widths
  - Reduced speed limits
  - Pedestrian detours/reduced footpath width
  - Stop/go systems in operation
  - Bus stop changes – We ask that you please refer to the Auckland Transport website or app and plan ahead.

Thank you in advance for your patience. We will ensure measures are in place to minimise any unnecessary disruption for the duration of this project.
