


Watermain Renewals

Kia ora,

From October 13, Watercare and our contractors will begin work to upgrade a section of watermain along Kapuni Road, Panmure (see map below). These works are a part of Watercare's Renewals Programme which replaces aging watermains, reducing the risks of leaks and disruption to the water supply of Panmure.



How will these works affect you?

- **Work hours:** Our standard work hours will be **7:00am to 5:00pm, Monday to Saturday.** Saturday work will be for a shorter duration.
- **Night works:** There may be up to **2–3 nights of work** required during the 3–4 week project. If needed, night works will run from **7:00pm to 5:00am.**
- **Noise:** Some noise is expected during construction, but we will keep it to a minimum and within the limits approved by Auckland Council.
- **Water shutdown:** Toward the end of the project, a temporary water shutdown will be required. Affected properties will receive **five days' notice**, and the shutdown will be scheduled to minimise disruption.
- **Water meter replacement:** Your property's water meter may be replaced during these works. If we need access to your property, we will let you know in advance.
- **Temporary changes in the area:** While works are underway, you may notice the following along Kapuni Road and nearby streets:
 - Reduced on-street parking
 - Narrowed lane widths
 - Reduced speed limits
 - Pedestrian detours or narrower footpaths
 - Stop/go traffic management in place
 - Bus stop relocations (please check the Auckland Transport website or app and plan ahead)

Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding as we complete this important upgrade for the Panmure community. We will ensure measures are in place to minimise disruption as much as possible during the project.
